She recognized that over the course of the past several weeks, she had learned to establish healthy boundaries and was implementing those techniques successfully. Excitedly, she shared that she knew she was moving forward, for the first time in her life. At the end of the session, SHE CHOSE TO BE SAVED, asking for forgiveness of her sins and accepting Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior. I humbly watched in wonder as God's amazing plan for our participant unfolded that day.
